What are 'Cookies'?

Some services on aebal Leisure site depend on cookies.

A cookie is a small text file deposited on your computer's hard drive, that allows your choices and information to be remembered between one page and the next. Some examples of what cookies do:

- Allow websites to recognise that you have already given a username and password (i.e. signed in to the site) so you don't need to do it for every web page requested.
- Allow site owners to understand the patterns of behaviour of users on the site, and so to improve the site. For example, they allow us to know which areas of the site are most used by our visitors.

What cookies are not:

Cookies do not allow aebal Leisure to "secretly" collect personal data about you. However, cookies are used to enable our website to handle the personal data that you may choose to provide to us, such as by completing an online form or registering with the website.

Our website can only access those cookies that it has created.

We do not have access to the cookies from other websites, and in turn other websites do not have access to cookies used by the aebal Leisure website.
